Subject: Declaration of result for recruitment of Constable (GD) in BSF, CISF, CRPF and SSB, Examination, 2011 –Declaration of Reserve List-2(consisting of candidates found FIT in Review Medical Examination) – reg.

Final result of Recruitment of Constable (GD) in Constable (GD) in BSF, CISF, CRPF and SSB, Examination, 2011 was declared on 18.11.2011 for 872 successful Female and on 28.11.2011 for 44,152 successful Male candidates. Vacancies were filled State-wise in Select List and on All-India basis in the Reserve List. Revised Result of 1881 candidates was also declared on 6.7.2012.

2. On the basis of Review Medical Examination and considering the number of unfiled vacancies, Commission has now decided to declare 6657 candidates, who have been recommended for appointment in the RL-2. The Category-wise details of these additional male/Female candidates are as under:-

4. The result has been prepared on the basis of data forwarded by CRPF in respect of 21,641 candidates found 'FIT in RME. While making allocation for Reserve List -2 (RL-2) following procedure has been adopted:-

- (i) Only those candidates have been considered for allocation in RL-2 who have obtained marks equal to or more than the lowest marks obtained by the candidates already selected in Reserve List for each CAPF and each category. By doing so, it is ensured that the candidates selected in the Select List and Reserve List already declared are not placed in a disadvantageous position vis-a-vis the candidates being included in RL-2.
- (ii) Candidates who had Blank/invalid options were considered for allocation in the RL-2 after substituting their preference as ABCD i.e. the default preference order in the Notice.
- (iii) Since the data in Verified Data for Date of Birth was in multiple formats so unverified Date of Birth has been used.
- (iv) For 695 candidates, whose Verified Data was not sent by CRPF, their Unverified Data was considered

5. Rank numbers have been allotted in merit order based on Total marks obtained by the candidates in the written examination. Tie cases have been resolved by -

- (a) Referring to the marks in Part A of the written paper i.e. a candidate having more marks in Part A is given preference.
- (b) If the tie still persists, the candidate older in age gets preference.
- (c) If the tie still persists, it is finally resolved by referring to the alphabetical order of names i.e. a candidate whose name begins with the alphabet which comes first in the alphabetical order gets preference.

6. Candidates in reserve list-2 will be en-bloc junior to candidates already selected in Select List/Reserve List as decided in consultation with Ministry of Home Affairs. The candidature of 243 candidates included in a separate list is provisional subject to verification of their details and will be finalised shortly. In case of 46 candidates, whose Roll Numbers are not prima-facie correct (in a separate list), a final decision in these cases will be taken in due course.

7. The lists are provisional subject to verification of their eligibility by the concerned CAPF before issuing appointment letters to selected candidates. The details of candidates, except for provisional cases, are already available with the CRP, the coordinating CAPF, who will arrange to send them to CAPFs to which the candidates are allotted.

8. The result in respect of 6352 male and 62 female selected candidates is available on SSC website <http://ssc.nic.in>. List of 243 provisional cases and 46 incorrect roll number cases is also available on SSC website.

9. Particulars of all the candidates found FIT in RME along with marks will be uploaded on SSC website shortly.
