Junior Hindi Translators (in Subordinate Offices) and Hindi Pradhyapak (Central Hindi Training Institute) etc. Exam, 2013 - declaration of final result

Staff Selection Commission conducted an open competitive examination of Junior Hindi Translators (in Subordinate Offices) and Hindi Pradhyapak (Central Hindi Training Institute) etc. Exam, 2013 for recruitment to the post of Junior Hindi Translators (in Subordinate Offices) and Hindi Pradhyapak (Central Hindi Training Institute) under Ministry of Defence on 2.6.2013 at different centres across the country. The result of **1720 candidates** declared qualified for evaluation of their Paper-II was declared on 23.09.2013.

2. On basis of marks obtained of Paper-II, **515 candidates** were declared qualified for being called for interview.

3. Keeping in view the vacancy position, category-wise details of the qualified candidates for appointment to the posts of Senior Translator and Junior Translator located in different cadres/posts are given below:- **(The rows pertaining to 0 vacancies/ no selected candidate have not been included in the tables:- (Category : 1- SC, 2- ST, 4 – OH, 5-HH, 6- OBC, 7-VH, 9- UR).**

4. There are **22 candidates whose candidature have been kept as Provisional** by concerned regional offices but are also included in the Select List. Concerned RDs/DDs will be required to check the eligibility of such candidates thoroughly before their nomination.

5. The said list is subject to the candidates fulfilling all the eligibility conditions prescribed in the notice of the said examination and also subject to, among other things thorough verification of their identity with reference to their photographs, signatures, handwritings etc. on the application forms, admission certificates etc. The candidature of the candidates are liable to be cancelled by the respective Regional Directors in case of the candidates found not fulfilling the eligibility conditions or for any other genuine reasons.

6. For candidates belonging to Reserved Categories for whom certain percentage of vacancies are reserved as per policy of the Government, the category status is indicated against their Roll Nos. It is important to note that some of these candidates have been declared qualified only in the category mentioned against their Roll Nos. If any candidate does not actually belong to the category mentioned against his/her name, he/she may not be eligible to be included in the list. It is, therefore, in the interest of the candidate concerned to contact immediately the respective Regional Office of the Commission in all such cases where they do not belong to the categories against their Roll Nos.
