

The **Staff Selection Commission (SSC)**, hereinafter called “Commission”, is one of the largest recruiting agencies of the Government of India. The Commission is mandated with the task of making recruitment to all Group ‘B’ (Non-Gazetted) and Group ‘C’ (Non-Technical) posts in various Ministries / Departments of the Government of India and their Attached and Subordinate Offices except those posts which are specifically exempted from the purview of the Commission. In addition, the Commission, from the year 2016, has been assigned the additional responsibility of making recruitments to Group ‘B’ (Gazetted) posts of Assistant Accounts Officer and Assistant Audit Officer for the Indian Audit and Accounts Department. Further, in the year 2021, the Staff Selection Commission has been entrusted with the responsibility of conducting recruitment examinations for the vacant Group ‘B’ (Non-Gazetted) and Group ‘C’ posts in Constitutional / Statutory bodies and the Union Territory (UT) of Ladakh.

Organisation:

The Commission comprises of a Chairman, 2 Members and a Secretary. The Head Quarter of the Commission is at New Delhi.

The Commission is headed by **Shri S.Gopalakrishnan, IAS, Chairman**.

The Southern Regional Office of the Commission is headed by **Shri Ragul K, IAS, Regional Director**.

The Southern Regional Office is located at **Chennai** and has its jurisdiction over the States of **Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Tamil Nadu & Union Territory of Puducherry**.
