IMPORTANT NOTICE

Subject: Exemption from appearing in Typing Test of CHSL- 2025 Examination (Tier-II) for PwD candidates – regarding.

As per Para No. 13.8.13.7 (vii) of Recruitment Notice of CHSLE 2025, Persons with Disabilities candidates who claim to be permanently unfit to take the Typing Test because of a physical disability may, with the prior approval of the Commission, be exempted from the requirement of appearing and qualifying at such test, provided such a candidate submits a Certificate in the prescribed format (**Annexure-XIV**) to the Commission from the competent Medical Authority, i.e., the Civil Surgeon of a Government Health Care Institution declaring him to be permanently unfit for the Typing Test because of a physical disability. In addition, such candidates must substantiate their claim by furnishing the relevant Medical Certificate in the prescribed format as per **Annexure-XI** to **Annexure-XIII** of the Notice of Examination, as applicable, at the time of Typing Test. Otherwise, their claim for seeking exemption from Typing Test will not be entertained by the Commission.

2. In terms of above provisions, the PwD candidates qualified from Southern Region seeking exemption from appearing in Typing Test may, in their own **interest**, send a request along with scanned copies of following documents to the email address: sscsr.pwd@gmail.com latest by **30.03.2026**:

(i) Medical Certificate seeking exemption in prescribed format (Annexure XIV of the notice of Examination) from the Competent Medical Authority, i.e., the Civil Surgeon of a Government Health Care Institution. It is again reiterated that candidates submitting Annexure-XIV should ensure that the certificate has the following:

- (a) Issued by Civil Surgeon.
- (b) Clearly indicate how the disability interferes with Typewriting.
- (c) Brief description of disabilities.
- (d) Percentage of disabilities

(ii) Undertaking as per the format annexed to this notice.

3. The decision of the competent authority on grant of exemption will be conveyed to the candidate on or before the day of Typing Test.

4. The candidates are required to produce all these documents in original as and when sought by the Commission or the Indenting User Ministries/Department/Organization.

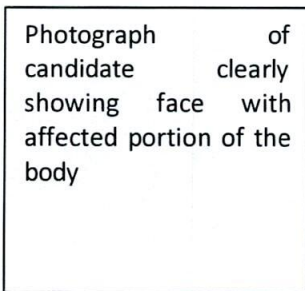
