ORDER : CANCELLATION OF CANDIDATURE OF 03 CANDIDATES FOR THE POST OF CT(GD) IN CAPFs, SSF AND RIFLEMEN (GD) IN ASSAM RIFLE THROUGH SSC CT(GD) EXAMINATION-2022

Reference is invited to the recruitment advertisement No. PPI01/11/2022-PP_1 for Constable (GD) in **Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs), SSF, Rifleman (GD) in Assam Rifles and Sepoy in Narcotics Control Bureau Examination, 2022** published by the Staff Selection Commission (SSC) on 27/10/2022. Following candidates had applied and appeared in the said examination. Their candidature was initially placed under the category of "Withheld" due to biometric mismatched.

2. Further, Staff Selection Commission, vide letter No. HQ-C-3007/1/2024-C-3 Part(5) (E-9399) dated 25.03.2025 and letter No. HQ-C-3007/1/2024-C-3 Part(2) (E-9158) dated 21.05.2025, has cleared 'Withheld result' after due verification of sample of Handwriting & Biometric data. The details of candidates with remarks/result are as follows:-

3. Further, in compliance to the directions issued by SSC (HQr) New Delhi, vide letter No. HQ-PP103/7/2024-PP-1-Part(1) dated 15.06.2023, received through MHA ID No. 45023/59/2022-PP(CF-3622488)/2059 dated 28.07.2023, that "at the time of appointment, the addresses mentioned in the domicile certificates of candidates should be verified through police or other appropriate means. If this verification process is not feasible for all candidates, at least the addresses of those candidates who have passed their matriculation examination from a State other than their domicile State should be verified at the time of appointment." Domicile/Residence certificate of above candidates were verified from their concerned issuing authority and remarks given by concerned civil authority are as under:-

- ❖ **Verification report of Office of The District Collector Jayashankar Bhupalpally District, Telangana in r/o Roll No. 1403002118 Pavan Rajak-** The Tahsildar, Bhupalpally has conducted local enquiry on the residence application number in respect of Sri. Pavan Rajak, S/o Hotam Rajak of Bhupalpally village and mandal in Jayashankar Bhupalpally District

and reported that, Application No. RC022309020896 (TSGGDG), Date: 14.06.2023 has not been residing in said residence address, at H.No. 1-52 Karalmarks Colony, Jangedu road, Bhupalpally village and mandal, hence the said **residence application number is not genuine**. Therefore, while enclosing the Tahsildar, Bhupalpally enquiry report of residence application number, it is **not genuine and found incorrect**.

- ❖ **Verification report of Office of the Tahsildar, Kagaznagar, Kumuram Bheem Asifabad District, Telangana in r/o Roll No. 8207011851 Vishnu Kumar-** The matter has been got enquired locally in Nazrulnagar Village No. 4 of Kagaznagar Mandal, during the enquiry it is revealed that the candidate Sri. Vishnu Kumar S/o Dalvir Singh is not a resident of Nazrulnagar and never resided in the village at the given D.No. 5-8B.

Further it is informed that D.No. 5-8 exist in the name of Sri. Gain Devendra Nath S/o Gain R/o Nazrul Nagar Village No. 4 and Sri Bijay Gain S/o Devendra Nath Gain Age 60 Years Occ: Agriculture and also runs a Kirana Shop in the village and he along with his family residing at the Door No. 5-8 of Nazrulnagar village No. 4 by birth and they have no relation with Sri. Vishnu Kumar S/o Dalvir Singh and he had never resided in the said address or in the village.

Further a report about D.No. 5-8B has been obtained from the Panchayat Secretary, Gram Panchayat Basantinagar. Vide Panchayat Secretary Lr. No. Nil, dated 20.08.2025, he has reported that H.No. 5-8B is not registered with any one and not belongs to Basantinagar Gram Panchayat and the documents submitted by Sri. Vishnu Kumar S/o Dalvir Singh is fake.

In view of the above it is to inform that Sri. Vishnu Kumar S/o Dalvir Singh had never resided in the said address or in the village and obtained the certificate by submitting the false documents.

- ❖ **Verification report of Office of the Tahasildar, Bhatli, Odisha in r/o Roll No. 3013193568 Manoj Yadav** – Resident certificate No. E-RES/2023/1189452, dated 24.06.2023 issued from this office has been cancelled for submission of fake documents and wrong declaration by the applicant. As per field level enquiry conducted by Revenue Inspector, Bhatli, it is found that, Manoj Yadav is not a permanent resident of village Bhatli, PS/Tha. Bhatli, Dist Bargarh. Certificate was cancelled from Tahsildar officer Bhatli for submission of fake documents.

4. As per the Notice of Examination for Constable (GD) 2022, the following provisions are relevant:

- (a) **Para 13.17:** "The candidates applying for the examination should ensure that they fulfill all the eligibility conditions for admission to the examination. Their admission at all the stages of examination will be purely provisional, subject to their satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions. If on verification, at any time before or after the Computer Based Examination. PST/ PET and Medical Examination as well as after issue of Offer of Appointment/ joining the Force/ Organization, it is found that they do not fulfill any of the eligibility conditions, their candidature/ selection for the post will be cancelled by the Commission/ CAPFs."

- (b) **Para 15.2:** "If candidates are found to indulge at any stage in any of the malpractices listed below during the conduct of examination or thereafter, their candidature for this examination will be cancelled and they will be debarred from the examinations of the Commission". It further provides that the candidates found indulged in malpractice of "Impersonate/Procuring impersonation by any person" will be debarred for 07 years."
- (c) **Para 16:** "The decision of the Commission in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of the applications, penalty for false information, mode of selection, conduct of examination(s), allotment of examination centres, debarment for indulging in malpractices, preparation of merit list and force allocation, etc. will be final and binding on the candidates and no enquiry/ correspondence in this regard will be entertained.

4. In accordance with the explicit provisions detailed in the relevant paragraphs of the Examination Notice, and pursuant to the verification remarks of concerned Civil Authority, the candidature of above 03 (three) candidates, whose domicile/resident certificate found not genuine cannot be sustained for the Constable (GD) post in CAPFs through the SSC CT(GD) Examination-2022. Accordingly, **the candidature of above 03 (three) candidates, is hereby cancelled with immediate effect.**

5. This order is passed in compliance with the notification & instructions issued by Staff Selection Commission and in conformity with the provisions of the examination notice.
